He is soon to be Deacon Lane Menezes and he is excited about his future here at All Saints University Parish and the Diocese of Stockton. His big day for ordination will be September 23rd at the Cathedral of the Annunciation. He will be ordained with six other men who have prepared for the past five years and are now ready to lay down their lives for Christ and the Church.

Born and raised a Catholic, Lane has always been a part of the Church. He has offered his gifts and talents over the years to St. Jude in Ceres and Sacred Heart here in Turlock. For the past five years he and his wife, Annette, and their three kids have made their home here at All Saints. Lane and Annette love being part of this community and look forward to doing all that they can to serve. These past five years have brought them closer together as they studied and prayed together for this momentous time. This February, Lane and Annette will celebrate their 30th wedding anniversary. The diaconal formation has strengthened their marriage covenant and deepened their love and commitment to God and to the Church.

Lane is very excited to join Deacon Eric who has been serving the All Saints community since his ordination on September 12, 2015. Lane “the Ranch Realtor” will continue to keep his regular job in agriculture real estate. This past year he has developed a special love for serving in prison ministry at Deul Vocation Institute, Tracy, and looks forward to serving these men as a deacon. Lane will be ready to serve the parish community at weekday and Sunday masses, funerals, weddings, baptisms, adoration, and wherever else he is needed. He stated, “I look forward to serving the people at All Saints and drawing them closer to Christ in the Eucharist.
