PASTORS CORNER

Dear friends,

First off, I want to congratulate everyone on a wonderful celebration of parish family, which occurred last weekend at our parish festival. Both the Cheers event on Friday night and the actual festival activities on Sunday evidenced the great enthusiasm and generosity that are so strong in this community of faith!! Special congratulations and gratitude go to Donna Roeck, the festival chairperson, who worked very hard to make sure that everything ran smoothly and successfully. Thanks very much Donna!!

If I started to try to mention the names of all of the important people who contributed so much for the festival, I would surely miss someone. Suffice it to say that we are grateful for all those who so generously gave of their time and talents to help with the festival!! Thanks also to all of those who donated food, auction items, and other goods to the festival.

Among other things, one thing that inspired me was the number of people, young and old, who pitched in to help with the cleanup on Sunday afternoon. I was amazed by how quickly we were able to accomplish the cleanup (which then gave me a chance to catch a quick nap :-).

It is important to let you know that the diocese has asked all parishes to join in an offertory increase program. While this is a very good program and could be helpful in many parishes, I don't think that it is a particularly good fit for our parish at this particular time. I have consulted with diocesan officials and have spoken with the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council about this. In light of the fact that I am new and probably temporary and in light of the fact that the parishioners have been so generous in so many different ways, I have proposed a different path and one that I think fits much better with all that has been unfolding here at All Saints. Since, in so many ways, many of you have been committed to building up this community and Kingdom of God through the sharing of your time, talent and treasure, it makes a lot more sense for us, as a community, to talk about the Spirituality of Stewardship, which is already being lived out here. Some of you may be well aware of the meaning of this word and understand this spirituality on one level or another. Others may not be familiar with it.

With the support of the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, my recommendation is that we, as a parish community, learn about and embrace Stewardship as a helpful spirituality to continue to energize the parish. I'm confident that this will help the parish to continue to move forward in a beautiful way in the love of Christ.
