### PASTORS CORNER

Dear friends,

Well, I have now been with you for a little more than a month and I want to say that it has been a great month. In former parishes where I've gone, the first month is often very stressful for various reasons. This has not been my experience at All Saints, thanks be to God!! I am very grateful for the beautiful and kind welcome I have been shown here by all of you. Even in the midst of your sadness at having to say goodbye to Fr. Matt, you have been kind and gracious and welcoming to me. It only serves to speak to me about a special quality found in this parish! It speaks of deep faith in Jesus Christ and in the reality that Spirit is at work in beautiful ways here!! I am excited about the next months and the journey that I am on with you as we continue to move forward and grow into God's plans for us.

As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, the spiritual concept that can bring us all together and help us to move forward is one that is already being lived out in this community, but without using the specific word to describe the spirituality of it. That word, that concept, and that spirituality is called "Stewardship".

Webster's Dictionary describes it as "the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care". Pope Francis has used it in this sense to talk about the importance of our taking care of creation and the environment. In 2015, he wrote an encyclical (letter to the faithful) called "Laudato Si", urging the world to take better care of God's creation and our environment. Recently, in September, he named care for creation a new spiritual and corporal work of mercy. No matter where one may stand on the political spectrum, I think we can all agree that care for our world and for our environment is a very important way that we can all exercise being good stewards!!

We will be continuing, in these months, to explore how a beautiful and lively caretaking has been going on here at All Saints and how we can help it to continue to flourish and blossom in the love of Christ.

We are forming a Stewardship Council very soon. If you have a particular interest in serving on this Council, please let me know. This week, we are sending one of our parishioners, Janet Riley, to the International Stewardship Conference in Nashville, TN. This year, the theme of the conference is "Missionary Disciples: Stewards of the Gospel." No doubt, it will be a great experience and Janet, who will serve on this council, will bring back lots of good information for us to reflect on.
